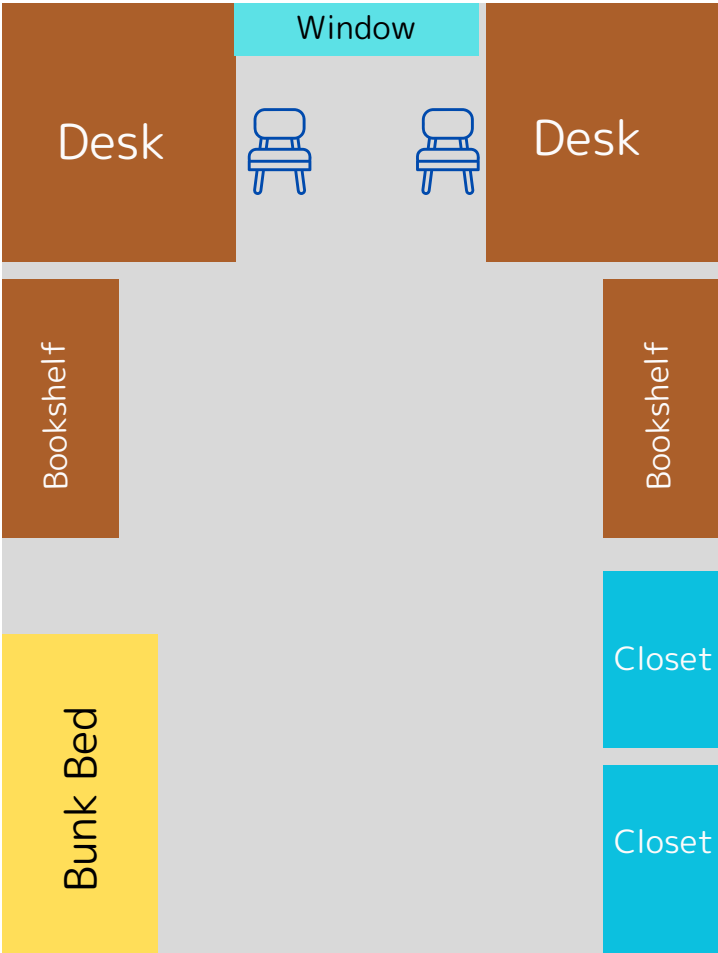

Public Space Facilities	
Internet:	Optical fiber (up to 100 Mbps) and wireless LAN on each floor and in the study room
Each floor:	Washing machines, clothes dryers (charged), 1-2 large refrigerators, toaster, electric irons, ironing boards
Pantry (kitchen) : 2 pantries on the 1F	Gas stove, microwave oven, gas oven, refrigerator
Storage :	2 prefabricated warehouses on 1F



The electricity in the Tokyo area, including TCU, is 100 volts, 50 cycle.

The Men's and Woman's Dorms are three story buildings with a capacity of approximately 100 students each. Each dorm room accommodates two students and is equipped with individual study desks and chairs, bunk-beds, individual chest-of-drawers, and book shelves. All rooms are air-conditioned.

In each dorm, there are two kitchen facilities with a microwave, small oven, rice cooker, refrigerator, and cooking utensils. All rooms have Internet access, and students can access the Internet with their own computers in the study rooms. The electricity in the Tokyo area, including TCU, is 100 volts, 50 cycle. Each dorm has a lounge and bathing facilities (both shower and Japanese style "ofuro"), and each of the three floors in both dormitories has prayer rooms, bathrooms, and a laundry room equipped with washing machines and dryers.
